

## Venus Flytrap Puppet Construction

- 1. Fold the paper plate in half.
- 2. Cut out the "jail bars" using the Venus jail bars template. Save some of the paper plate scraps for #8.
- 3. Open the paper plate and lay it flat.
- 4. Color the back, curved side of the plate green.
- 5. Lay the Venus mouth template in the center of the front, uncolored side of the plate.
- 6. Trace the template to create the circle in the center of the plate, the finger holes, and the trigger hairs.
- 7. Cut out the four finger holes.
- 8. Color two of the pointed scraps red and glue them to either side of the single finger hole as shown on the Venus mouth template.
- 9. Color the center circle on the front of the Venus flytrap red.
- 10. Color the outer circle of the jail bars green.
